# May 7<sup>TH</sup>

**Brush and Leaf Pick-up** Brush and Leaves must be placed in <u>separate piles</u> at curb by 8 a.m. on Wednesday, May 7<sup>TH</sup>. Tree removal will not be picked up!! Brush can be no longer than 5 ft. and should be piled parallel with the curb, with the cut ends all in the same direction. Separate piles are best, so the tractor can handle it. Small clippings, nuts, apples, grass clippings and all bagged leaves must be in biodegradable collection bags. Biodegradable bags are available at Wal\*Mart, Wegmans, etc. No plastic bags accepted. Any leaves with brush mixed in will not be picked up! NO EXCEPTIONS!

**Annual Spring Clean-Up Day** at the Village Shop from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Details will be in the Mt. Morris Shopper.

#### BRUSH PICK-UP SCHEDULE from May till October

(1<sup>ST</sup> WEDNESDAY OF EACH MONTH UNLESS HOLIDAY) WEDNESDAY ~ MAY 7, 2014 WEDNESDAY ~ JUNE 4, 2014 WEDNESDAY ~ JULY 2, 2014 WEDNESDAY ~ AUGUST 6, 2014 WEDNESDAY ~ SEPTEMBER 3, 2014 WEDNESDAY ~ OCTOBER 1, 2014 (FINAL BRUSH PICKUP FOR SEASON)

The Village DPW has asked residents to not place brush out until the weekend immediately prior to pick-up, and must be placed at the curb by 8:00 A.M. the morning of pick-up.

Leaf Pick-Up will begin mid-October and continue through Thanksgiving, weather permitting

#### VILLAGE SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

**Please Call the Village Office** at 468-2215 if you would like to have your sidewalk repaired by the Village DPW. The only cost to property owners is for the cost of materials. There is no charge for labor.

**To All Water Customers:** Please be advised that you must contact the Village Clerk's Office at 468-2215 to arrange a Temporary Stop to water service prior to seasonal travel in order to qualify for a partial exemption of water/sewer usage charges. A Final Bill will be issued at that time. Provided no usage is recorded during the billing period, you will only be responsible for debt service charges.
