BE IT RESOLVED that the Nunda Village Board of Trustees **adopt** the 2020-2021 Budget of the Village of Nunda as follows:

GENERAL FUND: \$ 625,447.00 SEWER FUND: \$ 248,458.00 WATER FUND: \$ 330,282.00 YOUTH RECREATION: \$ 22,982.00

Grand Total Amount is \$1,227,169.00 with \$461,744.00 to be raised by taxes for the General Fund at the Tax Rate of \$10.535859 per thousand with an increase of \$0.021242 per thousand assessed. The Water Debt Charge will increase \$0.72 from \$28.87 to \$29.59 per quarter, per living unit. The Sewer Debt Charge will increase \$0.17 from \$4.39 to \$4.56 per quarter, per Sewer Unit.

- C. Mayor Morgan stated he has been in contact with Livingston County Administrator and stresses the use of residents to call 211 when they are in need of assistance. Food Link will be distributing food in the near future at two locations in the county, Dansville and Geneseo. Also, the village is in contact with our CDBG Grant provider as to utilize some of these funds to help procure food for local residents.
- D. Deputy Mayor Snyder inquired about the CDBG Grant and resident applications. Administrator Wood stated he would inquire with Thoma Development Consultants as to receiving an updated list of applicants and their status.
- E. Deputy Mayor Snyder inquired about a survey for the Lawson Properties. Administrator Wood stated the village is following the Toolkit provided by NYSDEC in moving forward with land acquisition. The process is time consuming and with COVID-19 the process has slowed.
- F. Sidewalk to Kiwanis

MOTION was made by Trustee Allen to contract with two local residents to assist in the completion of sidewalk development on State Route 436 that will allow school students access to Kiwanis Park and provide greater safety measures for the public, this process is not to exceed \$1,000, seconded by Deputy Mayor Snyder. Carried 4-0.
